This poem by William Wordsworth is a celebration of the beauty of nature. Children will love the vivid imagery and the sense of wonder and joy.


5. "Ode to a Nightingale" by John Keats

This poem by John Keats is a beautiful and passionate ode to the nightingale. Children will appreciate the rich language and the sense of wonder and awe.


6. "The Lake Isle of Innisfree" by William Butler Yeats

This poem by William Butler Yeats is a beautiful and evocative ode to the simple life. Children will appreciate the simple language and the sense of peace and tranquility.


7. "The Tyger" by William Blake


