


Modern postcard of Ocean City, depicting the Ocean City Music Pier

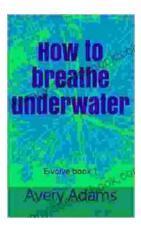
