

Make 100 Triangle, Diamond, and Hexagon Blocks in Various Sizes with Exciting Project Ideas

- Fabric (cotton, linen, or other woven fabric)
 - Scissors
 - Ruler
 - Rotary cutter (optional)
 - Cutting mat (optional)
 - Iron and ironing board
 - Sewing machine
 - Thread
1. Cut a square of fabric measuring 6 inches x 6 inches.
 2. Fold the square in half diagonally, right sides together. Press the fold.
 3. Unfold the square and fold the bottom two corners up to meet the center fold. Press the folds.
 4. Fold the square in half again, right sides together, matching the side edges. Press the fold.
 5. Stitch around the edge of the block, close to the edge, leaving a small opening for turning.
 6. Turn the block right side out and press.

1. Cut a square of fabric measuring 4 inches x 4 inches.
2. Fold the square in half diagonally, right sides together. Press the fold.
3. Unfold the square and fold in half again, right sides together, matching the opposite corners. Press the fold.
4. Fold the square in half diagonally, right sides together, matching the remaining corners. Press the fold.
5. Stitch around the edge of the block, close to the edge, leaving a small opening for turning.
6. Turn the block right side out and press.

1. Cut a strip of fabric measuring 2 inches x 12 inches.
2. Fold the strip in half lengthwise, right sides together. Press the fold.
3. Unfold the strip and fold each end up to meet the center fold. Press the folds.
4. Fold the strip in half again, right sides together, matching the side edges. Press the fold.
5. Stitch around the edge of the block, close to the edge, leaving a small opening for turning.
6. Turn the block right side out and press.
