

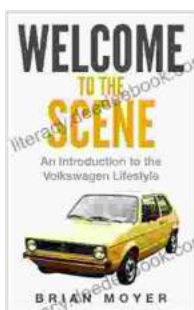

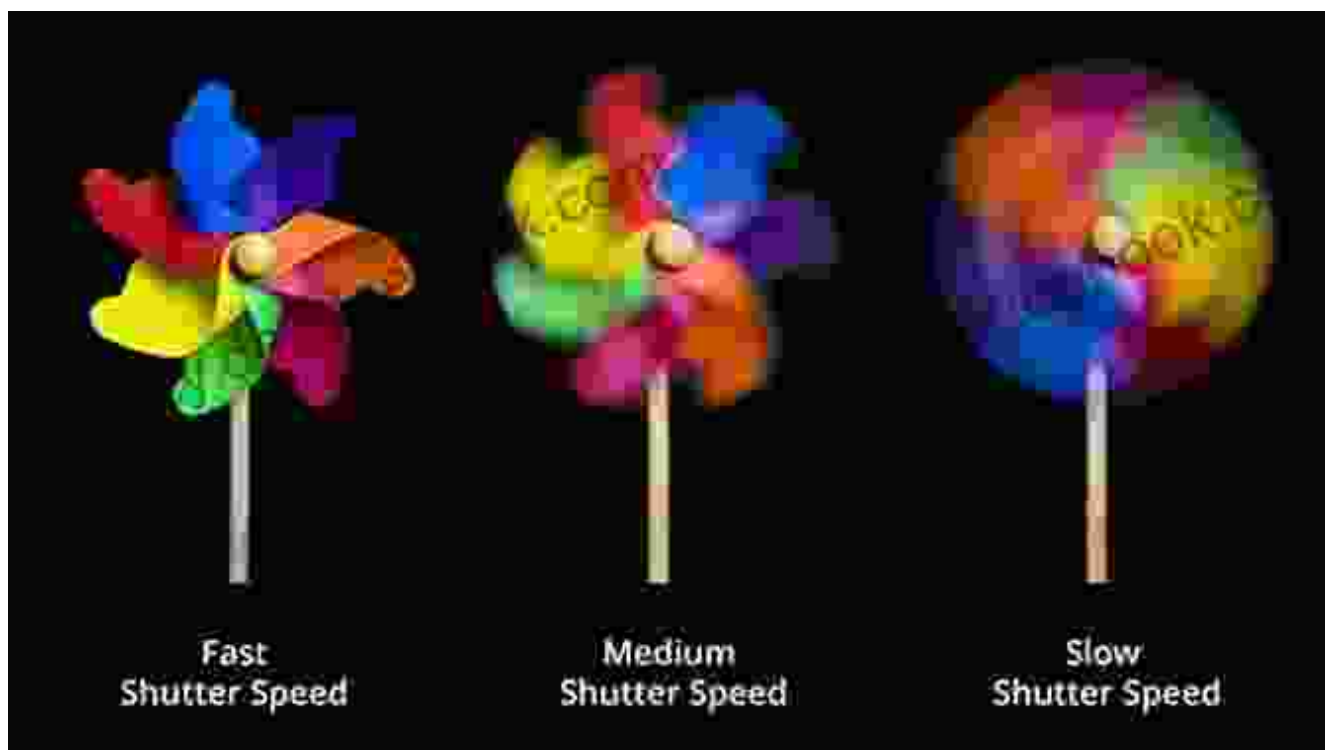

Shutter Speed

Shutter speed determines the duration the camera's shutter remains open, affecting the amount of time light exposes the film or sensor. Measured in seconds or fractions of a second (e.g., 1/125, 1/500, 2 seconds), a faster

shutter speed freezes motion, while a slower shutter speed creates motion blur.



Shutter speed controls the motion captured in a photograph.

ISO

ISO measures the sensor's sensitivity to light, affecting the brightness of the image. A higher ISO (e.g., 800, 1600, 3200) increases sensitivity but introduces more noise (grain) into the image. A lower ISO (e.g., 100, 200) reduces noise but requires brighter lighting conditions.

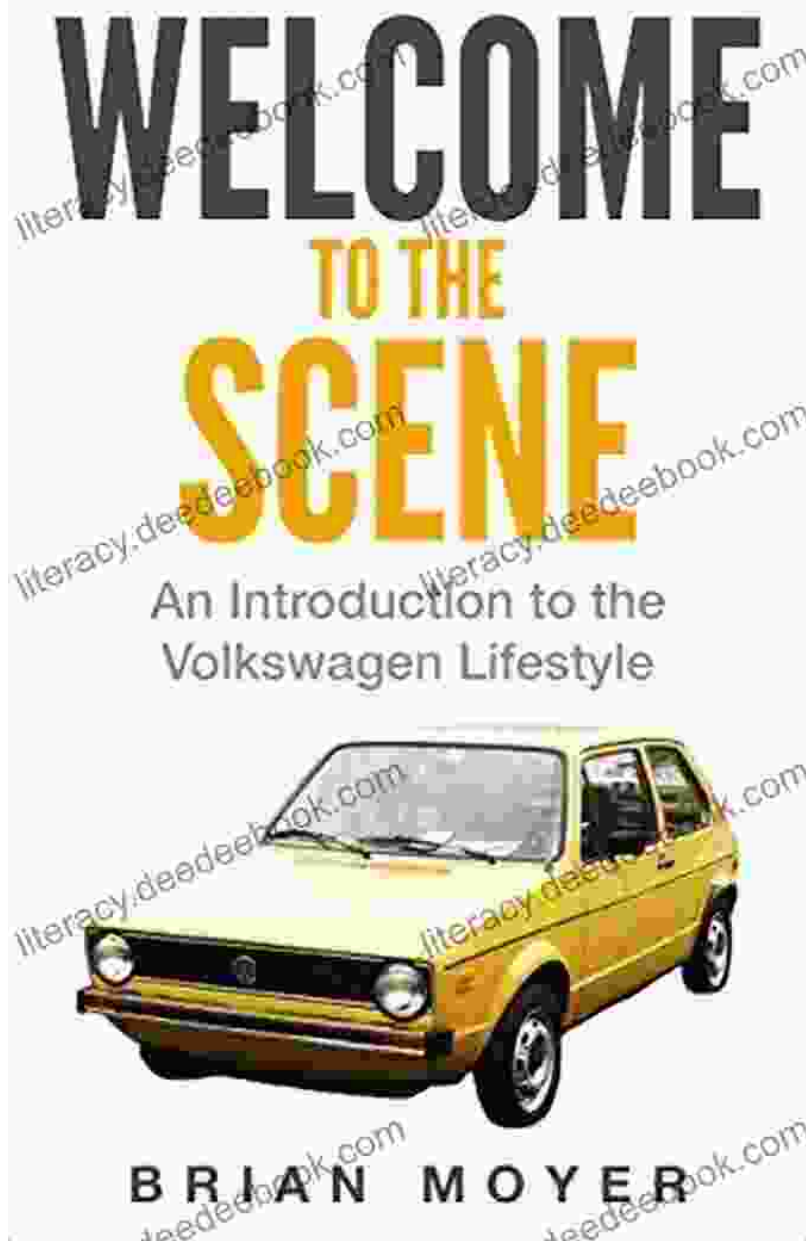

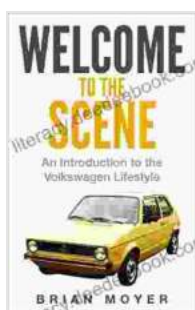

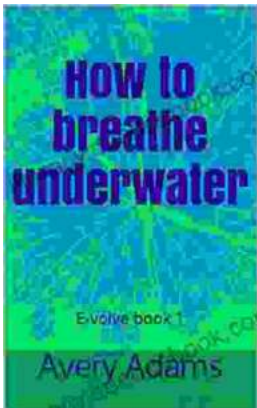
