Early Life and Career

Move to Liverpool

In January 2018, van Dijk moved to Liverpool for a fee of £75 million, making him the most expensive defender in history at the time. He quickly became a key player for Liverpool, helping them win the UEFA Champions League in 2019 and the Premier League title in 2020. Van Dijk has been named in the PFA Team of the Year for three consecutive seasons, and has also been named the Liverpool Player of the Season for two consecutive seasons.

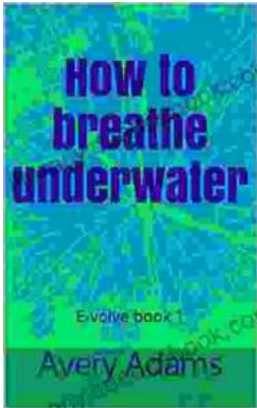
