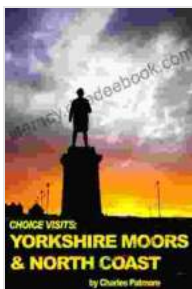

The Yorkshire Moors and North Coast is easily accessible by car, train, and bus.

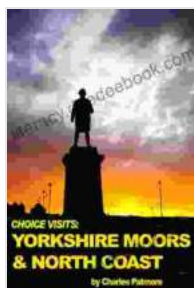
By car, the Yorkshire Moors and North Coast is located about 2 hours north of London. The M1 and A1 motorways provide easy access to the region.

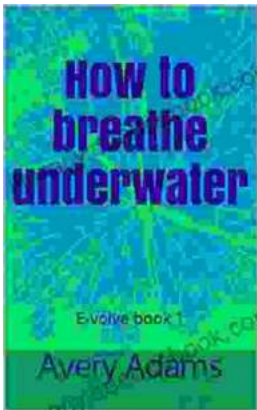
